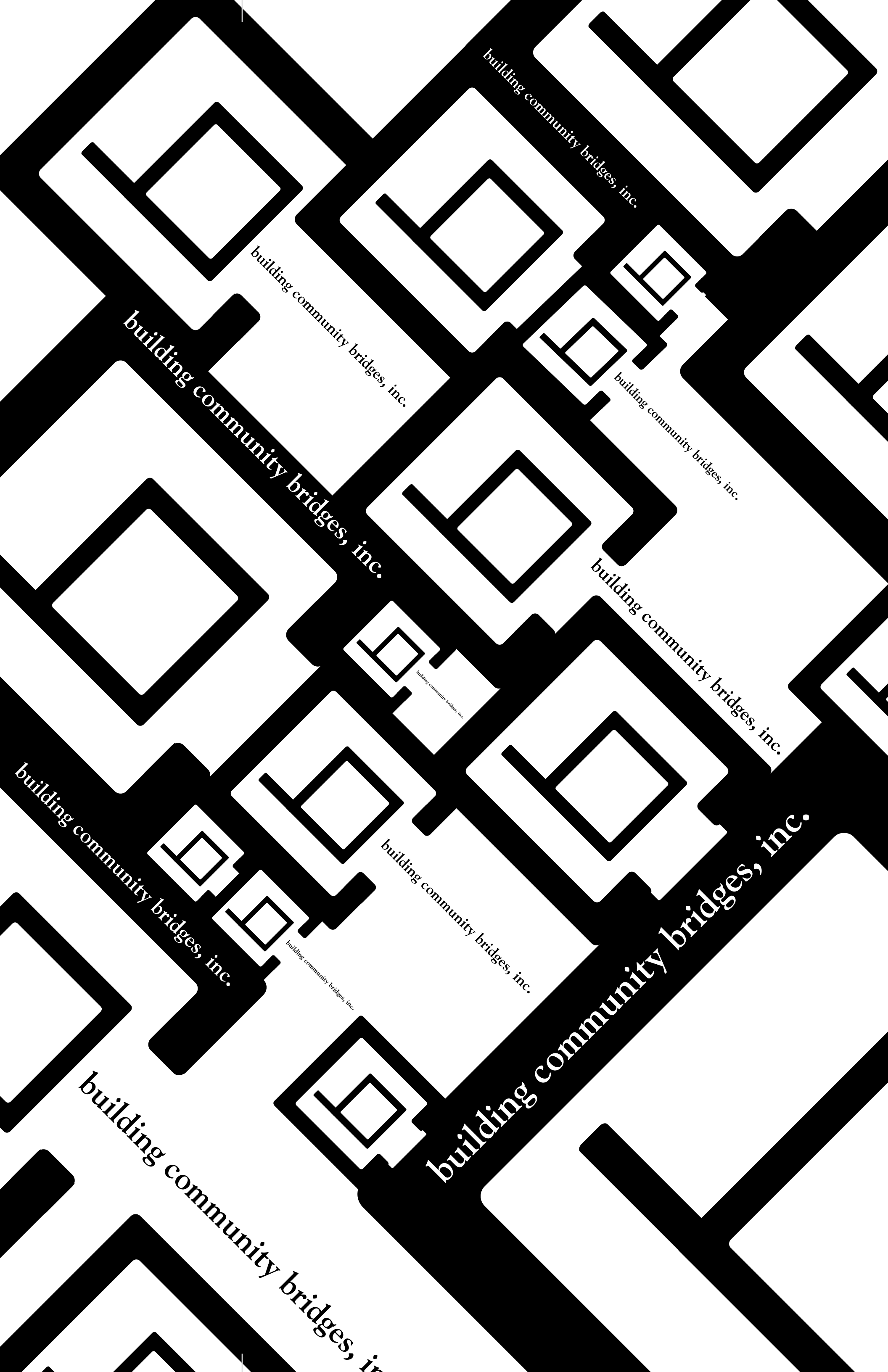
our goals
